Open House Transitional Living Program Helps End Youth Homelessness

WILMINGTON, NC –Coastal Horizons is thrilled to be celebrating the Open House Transitional Living Program's One Year Anniversary!

The Open House Transitional Living Program (TLP) is a Family and Youth Services Bureau funded program, and the only one of its kind in Wilmington, NC. The TLP is a safe, stable housing program that provides supportive services to help young adults toward self-sufficient, independent living.

Participants in the TLP receive monthly rental assistance for up to 12 months, aide in attaining employment and/or education, weekly meetings with a case manager to support individual goals, monthly life skills classes, and so much more. A participant may remain in the program for up to 12 months and receive 90 to 365 days of aftercare services, such as follow-up case management services and/or referrals to other agencies.

Individuals eligible to participate in the TLP must be between the ages of 16-21 years old, experiencing homelessness or at risk of experiencing homelessness, and willing to participate in an admissions process.
