## COASTAL HORIZONS URGES CURRENT AND FORMER MILITARY SERVICE MEMBERS NOT TO 'GO IT ALONE' OVER THE HOLIDAY SEASON

WILMINGTON, NC. The holidays can be a difficult time for anyone, and especially so for current military members, veterans, and family members of military service members. "Despite the bright lights and festive cheer, this time of year can bring about feelings of loneliness, isolation, grief, survivor's guilt, and sadness. For veterans still adjusting to civilian life, large crowds and loud noises can trigger PTSD symptoms," says Justin Gibson, Telemental Health Therapist with Coastal Horizons and Marine Veteran with two combat deployments to Afghanistan. "We need to look out for our service men and women during this vulnerable time. There is no need for them to 'go it alone.' Help is just a phone call away."

Coastal Horizons has partnered with local nonprofit Save a Vet Now Inc. (SAVN) in an endeavor to assist Veterans in our area with access to and receipt of outpatient treatment services. Coastal's SAVN Veterans Outreach Program utilizes a special account which is used to cover any co-pay or self-pay costs (that are not covered by State, Medicaid, Medicare or other 3<sup>rd</sup> party insurance funding) for treatment services at any of its Brunswick, New Hanover, or Pender outpatient locations.
